The Mayor will not normally allow audience participation at any other time. Idaho Law prohibits council action on items brought under this section except in an emergency circumstance.*

City Clerk Stegelmeier asked Mayor Stronks to call an emergency meeting because of the possibility of loss of money concerning the budget. The meeting was conducted via telephone.

Mayor Stronks explained that Cathy had underestimated the tax revenues in the Budget Proposal of August 8, 2007. The Budget will need to be amended and then notice published for the Public Hearing. The Public Hearing would be set for September 12, 2007 at 6:30 PM.

Councilwoman Janssen made a motion to dispense with the Budget Proposal dated August 8, 2007 and adopt the new Budget Proposal dated August 29, 2007. Councilman Huntsman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Stronks adjourned the meeting.
