### 1. ORDINANCES/RESOLUTIONS:

- A. City of Ashton Ordinance 434-08 – Adoption of the 2006 International Building Code. City Clerk Stegelmeier explained to the council that this ordinance was mandated by State Code and that City Building Inspector Jon Laux had been through the code and made some changes specific to Ashton. Councilman Brady related a spelling mistake in the draft. Mayor Stronks had asked earlier about the sprinkler system requirements and City Clerk Stegelmeier explained that Jon had spoken to the State Fire Inspector and was allowed to make a change to fit Ashton.

Councilwoman Janssen made a motion to dispense with 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> readings of the resolution and to read each resolution by title only. Councilman Brady seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Councilwoman Janssen read the Resolution into the record.

Councilwoman Janssen made a motion to approve the resolution. Councilman Brady seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken. The motion passed unanimously.

### 2. NEW BUSINESS/PETITIONS:

- A. Financial – City Interest Rates – Cathy Stegelmeier. The council read the city memo given them by City Clerk Stegelmeier listing the interest rates bid by the local banks and the Idaho Local Government Investment Pool. It was also discussed the possible need for withdrawal before the dates of some of the CD terms.

Councilwoman Janssen made a motion to approve put the funds in the Idaho Local Government Investment Pool. Councilman Huntsman seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
