- 1. Set minimum bid prices for surplus items for sale:** Mayor Stronks explained we have 3 surplus vehicles that will be for sale for the Centennial City Wide Garage Sale on July 7-8, 2006. We have a 1998 Ford Crown Victoria that was a police car - minimum bid set at \$1100.00, a 1996 Ford Crown Victoria that was a police car - minimum bid set at \$950.00, a 1989 Dodge Dakota pickup – minimum bid set at \$500.00. We also have a cast iron eagle claw tub that is in very good condition – minimum bid set at \$500.00. We have 5 motors that are also in surplus. Mayor Stronks said to call Electric Motor for an estimate on their prices to set a minimum bid. All other surplus items will be an open bid with no minimum amount. Item number 12 is “misc. police items”, Tom and Greg will handle these.
