Purpose of the Special Meeting:

1. Canvass Votes- The City Council has examined the returns of the special bond election and hereby canvasses the returns and declares the results of the election on the proposition of whether or not the city should issue its revenue bonds in the principal amount of \$1,500,000 for the purposes stated in Ordinance 416-05, adopted on April 13, 2005.

The total number of votes cast at said election for and against the proposition was as follows:

Total votes cast, 92; votes for, 87; votes against, 5.

Linda Janssen moved to adopt Resolution 05-22 declaring the bond election approved, seconded by Richard Huntsman. All in favor by roll call vote.

2. Cleanup List- Toni Kingsley reported on the cleanup list that she is working on. It was recommended that Sam Jones work with Toni on the non-compliance residents.

3. Records Preservation- Jane Daniels of the Ashton Archives has offered to copy for use and preserve original minute books of the City. We have had to do research and the old documents are falling to pieces. Linda reported that the archives is looking for an archival quality scanner.

Linda Janssen moved to allow Jane to pay for copies and preservation of the old minute books of the City of Ashton. Seconded by Brett Pincock, all in favor, motion carried.
